## Using the Bluetooth Scanner with Remote Desktop Connection

The BlueTooth scanner works with Remote Desktop Connection 6.0 on Windows 7 and higher. Make sure that that the scanner works locally first, then complete the following steps to make it work in Terminal Server:

- 1. On the Windows taskbar, click **Start > All Programs > Accessories > Remote Desktop Connection**.
- 2. Click Options.
- 3. Click on the Local Resources tab.
- 4. In the **Keyboard** drop-down list, select **On this computer**.
- 5. Under Local devices and resources, click More.
- 6. Select Serial Ports and Other supported Plug and Play (PnP) devices, then click OK.
- 7. Click **Connect**, log into Terminal Server, then click **Yes** to connect your computer.
- 8. Follow the instructions for setting up the scanner for Contributions and Accounts Receivable.
